

In April 1877 St Mary's school received what was described as "very favourable" Government report. In both the Infant and Mixed School reading was well taught. The infants were in very nice order and the intelligence of these children was "satisfactory." The Mixed School was described as in very

good order. Its examination results were highly creditable. It went on to say: "Considering the class of children, and the difficulty of securing regular attendance, the condition of this school is remarkably good, and reflects very great credit on the managers and teachers."
